1. Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy describes how Arhat USRP ('we,' 'us,' or 'our') collects, uses, and protects your personal information when you use our services, website, and applications.

1.1 Information We Collect

Personal Information

We may collect the following types of personal information:

- Name, email address, and contact information
- Account credentials and authentication data
- Payment and billing information
- Company and business details
- Communication preferences and history

Usage Information

We automatically collect information about your interaction with our services:

- Device information (IP address, browser type, operating system)
- Usage patterns and analytics data
- Log files and access times
- Cookies and similar tracking technologies

1.2 How We Use Your Information

We use collected information for the following purposes:

- To provide, maintain, and improve our services
- To process transactions and send related information
- To communicate with you about updates, security alerts, and support
- To personalize your experience and deliver relevant content
- To monitor and analyze usage patterns and trends
- To detect, prevent, and address technical issues or security threats
- To comply with legal obligations and enforce our agreements

1.3 Information Sharing and Disclosure

We do not sell your personal information. We may share your information in the following circumstances:

Service Providers: With third-party vendors who perform services on our behalf

Legal Requirements: When required by law or to protect our rights and safety

Business Transfers: In connection with mergers, acquisitions, or asset sales

With Consent: When you have given us permission to share your information

1.4 Data Security

We implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your personal information against unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure, or destruction. These measures include encryption, secure server infrastructure, access controls, and regular security assessments.

1.5 Your Rights and Choices

Depending on your location, you may have the following rights:

Access: Request access to your personal information

Correction: Request correction of inaccurate information

Deletion: Request deletion of your personal information

Portability: Request a copy of your data in a portable format

Opt-out: Opt-out of marketing communications and data processing

We retain your personal information for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Privacy Policy, unless a longer retention period is required by law. When information is no longer needed, we will securely delete or anonymize it.

1.7 Children's Privacy

Our services are not directed to individuals under the age of 18. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children. If you believe we have collected information from a child, please contact us immediately.

2. Terms of Service

These Terms of Service ('Terms') govern your access to and use of Arhat USRP's services, website, and applications. By accessing or using our services, you agree to be bound by these Terms.

2.1 Acceptance of Terms

By creating an account or using our services, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to be bound by these Terms and our Privacy Policy. If you do not agree, you must not use our services.

2.2 Account Registration and Security

To access certain features, you must register for an account. You agree to:

- Provide accurate, current, and complete information
- Maintain and update your information to keep it accurate
- Maintain the security of your password and account
- Accept responsibility for all activities under your account
- Notify us immediately of any unauthorized use

2.3 Acceptable Use Policy

You agree not to use our services to:

- Violate any laws, regulations, or third-party rights
- Transmit harmful, threatening, abusive, or harassing content
- Interfere with or disrupt our services or servers
- Attempt unauthorized access to our systems or user accounts
- Use automated systems to access services without permission
- Impersonate any person or entity
- Engage in any activity that could harm our reputation or operations

2.4 Intellectual Property Rights

All content, features, and functionality of our services, including but not limited to text, graphics, logos, software, and code, are owned by Arhat USRP and protected by copyright, trademark, and other intellectual property laws. You may not copy, modify, distribute, or create derivative works without our express written permission.

2.5 Subscriptions and Payments

For paid services:

- Fees are billed in advance on a recurring basis

- All fees are non-refundable unless otherwise stated
- You authorize us to charge your payment method automatically
- We may change fees with 30 days' notice
- You may cancel your subscription at any time

2.8 Limitation of Liability

TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, ARHAT USRP SHALL NOT BE LIABLE FOR ANY INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, SPECIAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES, OR ANY LOSS OF PROFITS OR REVENUES, WHETHER INCURRED DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY. OUR TOTAL LIABILITY SHALL NOT EXCEED THE AMOUNT YOU PAID US IN THE 12 MONTHS PRECEDING THE CLAIM.

These Terms shall be governed by and construed in accordance with applicable laws. Any disputes arising from these Terms or our services shall be resolved through binding arbitration, except where prohibited by law.

We reserve the right to modify these Terms at any time. We will notify you of material changes via email or through our services. Your continued use after changes constitutes acceptance of the modified Terms.

3. Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy explains how Arhat USRP uses cookies and similar tracking technologies when you visit our website and use our services.

3.1 What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your device when you visit a website. They help websites remember your preferences, authenticate users, analyze traffic, and provide personalized experiences. Cookies may be set by the website you visit (first-party cookies) or by third parties (third-party cookies).

3.2 Types of Cookies We Use

Essential Cookies

These cookies are necessary for our website to function properly. They enable core functionality such as security, network management, and accessibility. You cannot opt out of these cookies.

Performance and Analytics Cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors interact with our website by collecting and reporting information anonymously. This includes metrics such as page views, session duration, bounce rates, and traffic sources. We use this data to improve our services.

Functional Cookies

These cookies enable enhanced functionality and personalization, such as remembering your preferences, language settings, and login status. They may be set by us or third-party providers whose services we use.

Targeting and Advertising Cookies

These cookies track your browsing activity to deliver relevant advertisements and measure campaign effectiveness. They may be set by our advertising partners and can track you across different websites.

3.3 Specific Cookies We Use

Session Cookies: Temporary cookies that expire when you close your browser

Authentication Cookies: Keep you logged in during your session

Google Analytics: Track and analyze website usage patterns

Preference Cookies: Remember your language, region, and display settings

Security Cookies: Detect fraud and protect against unauthorized access

3.4 Third-Party Cookies

We work with third-party service providers who may set cookies on your device. These include:

- Google Analytics for website analytics

- Payment processors for secure transactions
- Social media platforms for sharing functionality
- Advertising networks for targeted advertising

These third parties have their own privacy policies, and we do not have control over their cookies.

3.5 Managing Your Cookie Preferences

You have several options to manage cookies:

Browser Settings

Most web browsers allow you to control cookies through their settings. You can set your browser to refuse cookies or delete certain cookies. However, disabling essential cookies may affect the functionality of our website.

Cookie Consent Tool

When you first visit our website, you will see a cookie consent banner. You can manage your preferences at any time through our cookie settings tool available in the website footer.

Our mobile applications may use similar technologies such as SDKs, pixels, and device identifiers for tracking and analytics. You can control some tracking through your mobile device settings (e.g., advertising ID settings on iOS and Android).
